### **More Important News**

#### Homework

In grade 5/6 homework is given to prepare students for secondary school. The tasks are designed to help students become organised by learning how manage their time and return the work by the due date.

It is our expectation that all students will hand in their homework by the due date. Students will be advised of the consequences of not handing in their homework. Please support and encourage your child to complete these tasks. If you are unsure or your child is ever unsure about the task, please encourage them to come and see their teacher before the given due date. Homework club will begin in term two.

#### **English**

During Term 1 we will focus our writing on establishing the use of Writer's Notebooks and persuasive writing. Through reading, children also learn about writing and the ways authors connect ideas to tell stories or share information. Reading is a good way to build understanding of grammar and the use of punctuation. The more children read the better readers and writers they become! Please encourage your child as a reader to actively look for a series, genres and books that engage them.

Students should be reading a minimum of five times each week for at least 10 minutes- this will be a part of our weekly homework.

#### Maths

Please encourage your child to practice their times tables at home as knowing these will help in many mathematical applications. Students will continue completing our Blitzmaster program 3 times per week. Our applied maths topic for the term will be Geometry. Our Beyond Curriculum extension program will continue to run this year.

## Compass

Classroom teachers will continue to use Compass to keep in contact with parents. We will aim to give you weekly updates on what is happening at school and for any reminders. Please come and see Flick if you are unable to log onto compass for any reason. Notifications can be set up through your compass app also so that you are always kept up to date.
